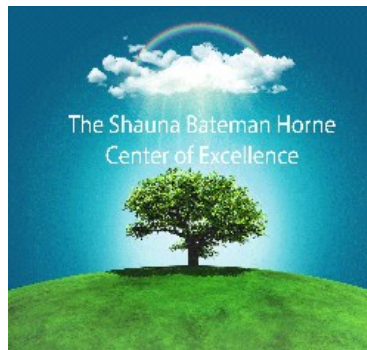

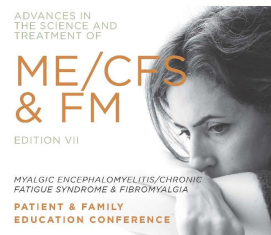
Research (OFFER) Letter of Intent:
